"Jesus was born into love or When things do not go quite as planned" - Mt 1:18-24

We have a saying in our family – Don't worry. It will either be perfect, or it will be a story. What a story Joseph has given us in the Gospel today! Perhaps his dream was to follow the Jewish traditions and marry his betrothed. But then, things did not go as planned. Mary became pregnant and all of a sudden Joseph could not follow tradition. He could not send her away in disgrace. His love was stronger than rules, and this kind man chose not to banish Mary publicly. Joseph is a thinking man. Even his initial response teaches us to think when confronted with the unexpected, instead of blindly following traditional norms.

In today's Gospel we hear that this is in preparation for Joseph to be given a glimpse of God's great plan. "An Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife." Even before Joseph knew this, he came from a place of love. His actions foreshadow the beatitudes. They foreshadow the times when Jesus tries to get the Pharisees to act out of love, not the letter of the law. They foreshadow Jesus' whole message of a merciful God who loves us.

Lord, at this time when you sent your Son to earth to teach us of your love, please help us see Your miracles, your loving touches, especially when things do not go according to our plans.

From the Rector's Desk

4th Sunday of Advent/Christmas/Holy Family
December 21, 25, 28, 2025

I'm praying and working on the varied homilies required in quick succession during this season, and in the wisdom of Alcoholics Anonymous, I'm taking it 'one day at a time'. I'm also shrewdly delegating with happy abandon to others to share the 'light burden' of Christ's sacramental proclamation, thanks to Deacon Philip, Frs. Claude and Sean and even Bishop Gary who will preside at 11:00 Christmas Day and the same on the feast of the Holy Family where he'll officially close the Jubilee Year of Hope. With the flurry of holy activity over this Advent/Christmas season, this bulletin will suffice for two weeks and we'll plan to publish again for the weekend of the Epiphany on January 4th 2026. Part of the flurry is the launch of the Simbang Gabi nine Masses which take us to Christmas Eve. It was my joy and privilege to preside at the first night with some 750 people who braved a cold and stormy night and found shelter in the warmth of Christ's Church and the inspiration of his presence in Holy Mass. I thank God for the vibrant faith of the Filipino community in Victoria and rejoice in their integration into the Cathedral community. There are too many signs of God's blessing and initiative to mention, but two are worth noting. After recruiting youth into a makeshift choir to sing "Rejoice in the Lord Always" last Sunday, I have since had three offers to organize something more consistent... Alleluia. Let's pray it comes to fruition. The other is a recurring thought about the soup kitchen community's needs. Their needs are so great and we're certainly helping with a loving daily nutritious meal for the body. But in conversation with a couple of our retired medical personnel, I wonder about offering consultations on health and well-being. Added to the mix could be some spiritual guidance and accompaniment. What do you think? Speak Lord for your servants are listening!

Dcn Philip Yuson will be preaching both, the New's Year's Masses of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, which I hope you'll recall is a **Holy day of obligation**. The Canadian Bishops have determined that Canadian Catholics are required to participate in only two days of worship outside of Sunday; December 25 and January 1st. The former isn't an issue, but the latter certainly has been. I hope you've continued to enjoy the witness talks after the Advent Sunday Masses, as I have. It takes considerable courage to get up in front of a large congregation and speak of one's spiritual life, but all have risen to the occasion and testified that our faith in the incarnate 'Word' is real and Jesus is active as the 'hound

of heaven' in pursuing souls, even in (and especially because of) our highly secular culture. Two men and one woman will offer a glimpse of their RCIA story at this weekend's 3 Masses that I celebrate. Part of the reason for this Advent adventure in faith, is to inspire you to consider inviting someone to Christmas Masses, who otherwise might not consider coming. The personal invitation is the best method of evangelization and sometimes can totally change lives for the better.

My life is unquestionably so much more fulfilling because of Jesus and his body, the Church. I was reminded of this when last Sunday, all the youth Mass servers presented me with a gift and note of appreciation for Christmas. "Thank you for always being so warm and welcoming towards us servers. Even when we make mistakes, you guide us through it and are so understanding.... We appreciate having you as our priest..." Wow, I'm not particularly sentimental, but that really touched my heart. The fact is I'm the one so blessed to be serving with all of you! The enormous contribution that these beautiful young servers, and the countless other volunteers offer to Christ whose humble and holy Bethlehem arrival we celebrate at Christmas is so true and good. From all of us staff who serve you and are served by you, with hearts full of gratitude, we wish you and yours a very rewarding Christmas of peace, charity, and hope.

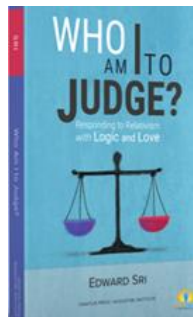
Chalice Christmas Gift Catalog
