Reflection

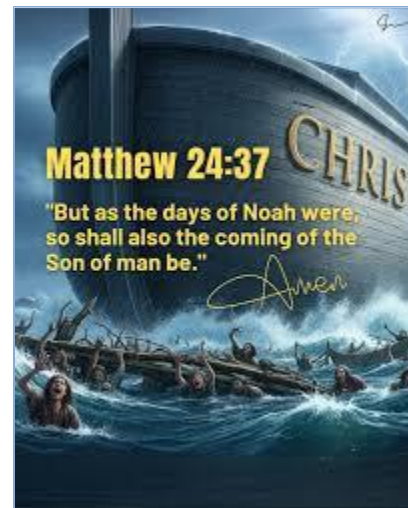
Jesus says that when He comes again, it will be like the days of Noah. People then were busy with everyday life: eating, drinking, getting married—doing normal things. But they were not paying attention to God, so the flood surprised them.

Jesus uses this story to teach us that His return will also come suddenly, when we are not expecting it. Two people may be working side by side, but only one will be ready. Being “ready” does not mean being scared or constantly watching the sky. It means living each day close to God.

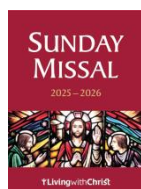
Jesus' message is: **“Stay awake. Be ready.”**

This means:

- Pay attention to your relationship with God.
- Live in a way that pleases Him.
- Don't let life's busyness make you forget what matters most.



Jesus wants us to live wisely, lovingly, and faithfully so that whenever He comes—today, tomorrow, or far in the future—He finds us walking with Him.

From the Rector's Desk

Advent 1 – November 30th 2025 (Feast of St. Andrew the Apostle)

I lament to inform you of the sudden passing of one of our Diocesan priests, Fr. Frank Franz. Apparently, he suffered a heart attack last Wednesday, was taken to the Royal Jubilee and died there on Sunday the 23rd, the feast of Christ the King. It's a bit of a shock! Fr. Frank served the Diocese in his retirement years filling in for holidaying pastors, and significantly for me, covered at Our Lady of the Rosary in 2023 when I took a two-week pilgrimage to the Holy Land, followed by 5.5 months in Baja California Mexico on a language sabbatical. We will miss him, pray for his sister Ardene who has been part of the Cathedral family, and pray that his soul rests in the perpetual light of Christ. Plans are for Bishop Gary to celebrate a memorial Mass at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday December 4th. Fr. Frank Franz R.I.P.

What a joy it was to witness the incredible range of Catholic musical traditions offered at the "Carols of Hope" fundraising celebration at Coastline Church last Sunday. The multiple parish support for Our Lady of the Rosary's new Church/Hall construction was heartwarming and Fr. William reports that approximately \$50,000.00 will contribute to their costs. At the Cathedral, we celebrated at weekend Masses two infant baptisms and six adult confirmations in the midst of blessing the new icon of St.



Andrew the Apostle (pictured). I hope many have participated in the Novena to St. Andrew which encourages us to practice his courageous witness to Jesus by bringing others to him. Even though the 30th falls on the first Sunday of Advent, we'll acknowledge our Patron at Mass. Our month of remembrance makes way this weekend

for the month of anticipation. The Binder of Life with names of our deceased family members, as well as the banners of the holy Cathedral souls will be replaced with the Advent Candle Wreath for our four-week countdown to Christmas.

Small group fellowships are important in a large parish like ours and I hope you can find one (or create one) that assists your need for Christian growth, love and

fellowship. Thanks to a team led by Teresa Vogel; a wonderful social luncheon was led Thursday after Mass for my fellow seniors in the parish dining room. We enjoyed conversation and laughter as we played Catholic Jeopardy. Watch out for news about the next gathering for seniors Shrove Tuesday. We have another upcoming gathering with young adults (18-30) on Saturday after the Sunday anticipatory Mass for fellowship and ministry planning. During Advent Sunday Masses we'll hear from numerous people offering a 'witness talk' after the Mass and answering the question: "What is drawing you to Christ and the Catholic Church?". They are all coming from recent and current formation within the 'Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults' which has a city-wide total of 66 candidates, 40 of whom come from the Cathedral Parish. My hope is you'll be inspired knowing that the Holy Spirit is moving in people's lives to draw closer to Jesus within the 'fold' of his Church. As we all need continual conversion, I also hope you'll avail yourself of the sacrament of reconciliation with numerous priests for a Penitential Service the evening of Tuesday December 9 at 7:00 p.m. As we clergy don the purple vestments of penance and preparation, Advent reminds us to be ready to celebrate Christ's first coming in Bethlehem, his second coming in Glory and judgement, and his continual coming in grace. Have a blessed Advent. St. Andrew our patron, pray for us!

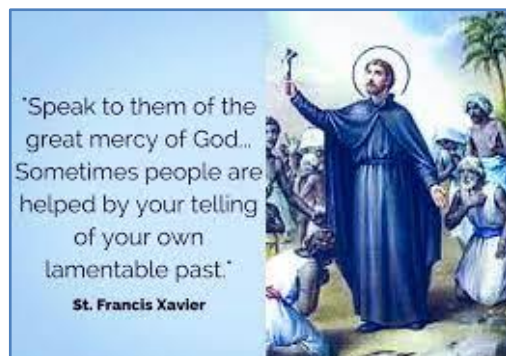

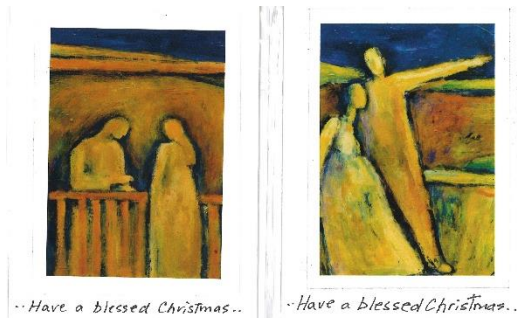

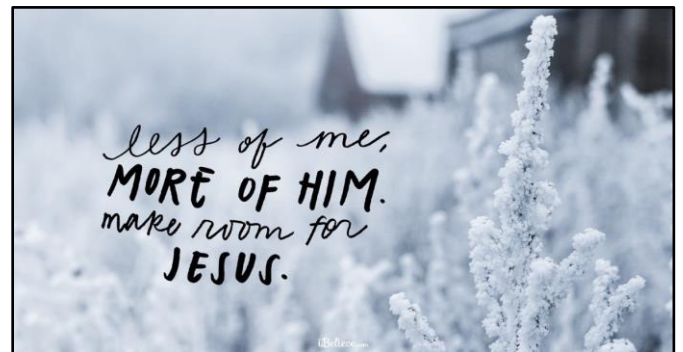
