Sacramental Information

Baptism: If you are seeking the Baptism of an infant, please contact the parish office at 250-388-5571. As Baptism is the first Sacrament of initiation into the Christian faith, we expect that the parents (or guardians) desire to raise the child in the Christian faith and will attend Mass regularly.

Marriage: Because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

Funeral: Individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

From the Rector's Desk

20th & 21st Sundays in Ordinary Time

Five of us clergy and a Church full of the lay faithful joined Fr. Eduardo Santos recently at Our Lady of Fatima parish to celebrate God's faithfulness in his 35 years of priestly ordination. During his homily he shared something of his story as a Brazilian seminarian who obtained his Doctorate in Spain and taught theology while pastoring in Brazil. A hunger to serve the Lord in a missionary capacity led him to Edmonton and then to Victoria where he has transferred his 'incardination' from Brazil and become one of our Diocesan Clergy. As he serves the Portuguese community who founded OLF, his ministry has also enveloped the Latino community of Victoria with joy and gratitude. Thanks be to God for Fr. Eduardo and the clergy and religious of our Diocese who have said "yes" to God's call. Anyone with a sense of 'calling' to serve the Lord as a priest or religious, please speak with Fr. Claude or me and we'll begin to pray and discern the voice of the Lord together.

I've often joked that the 3 states of activity at the Cathedral are 1) busy, 2) busier, and 3) busiest. Right now, we're just busy with our regular schedule of Eucharistic liturgies and sacramental occasions for confession; in addition to a significant number of weddings and validation ceremonies, and an occasional need for a funeral or memorial service. I've just obtained a copy of our Diocesan sacramental statistics and happily note a substantial increase in 2025 over 2024 in most cases. Total baptisms have increased from 264 to 354. Marriages are up from 57 to 65 and confirmations increased to 380 from 287. It's good to be trending up, but all sacramental numbers are well below 25 years ago: Total baptisms in 2000: 503; confirmations 511; marriages 144. Let's hope we've 'hit bottom' and truly gaining spiritual ground for the mission of Christ to lost souls of Vancouver Island.

In addition to the prayerful extension of the noon Mass on Wednesdays with 2 hours of exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and adoration, I'd like to propose another community faith opportunity by calling all children from grade 1 to grade 7 who would like to form a Cathedral Children's Choir. We have a committed and very accomplished pianist and are looking for an assistant conductor/organizer. Plans are for practices to take place between the Sunday 9 and 11 Masses on occasion starting in the fall. Parents who think their children would be interested, please inform the office, attention to Iason our music director.

This coming week we will host a second meeting of our View St. store/business owner neighbors with Soup Kitchen leadership and representatives of the police and

City of Victoria. It's an unfortunate necessity to discuss ongoing challenges caused by some members of the street community and a disproportionate amount of social disorder, crime and time consumption. Pray for us! Much more pleasant will be the annual Diocesan family camp gathering at the Nanoose Bay Pentecostal Camp August 21-23. I'll be attending on the Friday and return for the Saturday confessions and Mass on Saturday. This wonderful faith builder for our Diocese came out of the seed of a children's camp that ran successfully for two summers at Sooke's Camp Bernard but seemingly died after my energy transferred to a World Youth Day pilgrimage to Madrid. But as Jesus said "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit." Congratulations to the lay leadership that has kept this terrific Diocesan ministry faithfully functioning for over a decade.

God bless you all with a peaceful summer even as we remember those in parts of the world suffering terribly from wildfires, earthquakes and war. God help us all.

Call to Prayer

Summerland Wildfire Survivors

Fr. Dean has been in touch with parishes in Penticton to ask if there was anything to be done substantially to support them amidst the influx of evacuees fleeing forest fires in the Okanagan. Their only request is that we hold the victims, firefighters, and all who those supporting them in prayer.

Support Earthquake Victims in Colombia

Our hearts are with the people of Colombia following the devastating earthquake that struck the country on August 10.

The magnitude 7.4 earthquake, centred near San José del Palmar in the department of Chocó, caused widespread destruction across western Colombia. The regions of Chocó, Valle del Cauca, Risaralda, Quindío and Caldas were particularly hard hit, with significant damage reported in cities including Cali, Pereira, Manizales, Armenia, and Quibdó.

The human toll has been heartbreaking. As of August 13, at least 273 people have lost their lives, more than 3,800 have been injured, and many remain missing. Thousands of homes, schools, hospitals, roads, and other critical

infrastructure have been damaged or destroyed. More than 150 aftershocks have further compounded the suffering and uncertainty faced by survivors.

This tragedy touches our community in a very personal way. Many members of our Latin American community come from Colombia, including the affected regions, and several have family members and friends who have been directly impacted.

In response, we are encouraging our community to support relief efforts through Development and Peace – Caritas Canada, which has launched an emergency collection to assist those affected by the earthquake. Their partner, Cáritas Colombiana, is already on the ground providing emergency aid, including food, water, clothing, medicines, hygiene kits, emergency supplies, psychosocial support, and pastoral care, with priority given to the most vulnerable families.

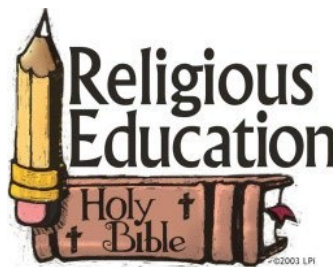
Thank You from Chalice!

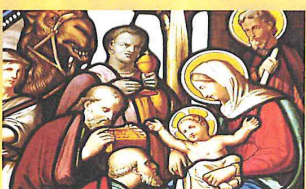

- Apr. 26 Afternoon departure from Vancouver to Venice.
- Apr. 27 Afternoon arrival in Venice. Transfer to hotel in Venice for rest, dinner and overnight.
- Apr. 28 Full day in Venice. We relish the sights and sounds of this serene city including canal cruise by motor launch to St. Mark's Square. We view the bridge of Sighs, Doge's Palace and St. Mark's Basilica. Afternoon Mass, some free time for leisure before returning to the hotel in Venice for dinner and overnight.
- Apr. 29 Today we travel to Siena. We stop in Padua and we visit Basilica of St. Anthony, his tomb and we celebrate Mass. Continue to Florence, the cradle of the Renaissance. Our guided tour of the city takes us to view the church of Santa Croce, a visit to the basilica of Santa Maria del Fiore, Piazza Signora and Ponte Vecchio. Dinner and overnight in Siena area.
- Apr. 30 Our tour of Siena includes the old city, Piazza del Campo, Duomo and St. Catherine Basilica where we celebrate Mass. Some free time before transfer to Assisi, the city of St. Francis, for dinner and overnight.
- May 01 Full day in Assisi. We visit the church of St. Maria degli Angeli with a chapel built by St. Francis (Porziuncola). Continue to the Basilica dedicated to St. Francis. We also visit the Sanctuary of the Spogliazione where St. Carlo Acutis is buried. Some free time before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.
- May 02 This morning, we depart to San Giovanni Rotondo. En route we stop in Lanziano, the site of the Eucharistic Miracle. Continue to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight.
- May 03 We start our day with Mass at the Church where Padre Pio said Mass most of his days, and then we visit his tomb and the museum. Afternoon we depart for Monte de San Angelo, the oldest shrine in Europe dedicated to the archangel Michael. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.
- May 04 Today we travel to Rome. En route we stop in Monte Cassino, site of the oldest Benedictine monastery and witness of one of the fiercest battles of the WWII. Upon arrival in Rome Mass, dinner and overnight.
- May 05 This morning, we attend the Audience with the Holy Father. Afternoon our tour of Rome takes us to the Basilica of St. Paul's in Chains, the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore, view the Coliseum and Forum Romanum. Mass in one of the churches in Rome. Dinner and overnight.
- May 06 After breakfast we visit the famous Vatican Museum including the Sistine Chapel and the Basilica of St. Peter. Mass in one of the churches in Rome, some free time, dinner and overnight.
