## Sacramental Information

**Baptism:** If you are seeking the Baptism of an infant, please contact the parish office at 250-388-5571. As Baptism is the first Sacrament of initiation into the Christian faith, we expect that the parents (or guardians) desire to raise the child in the Christian faith and will attend Mass regularly.

**Marriage:** Because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

**Funeral:** Individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

### Ascension of the Lord

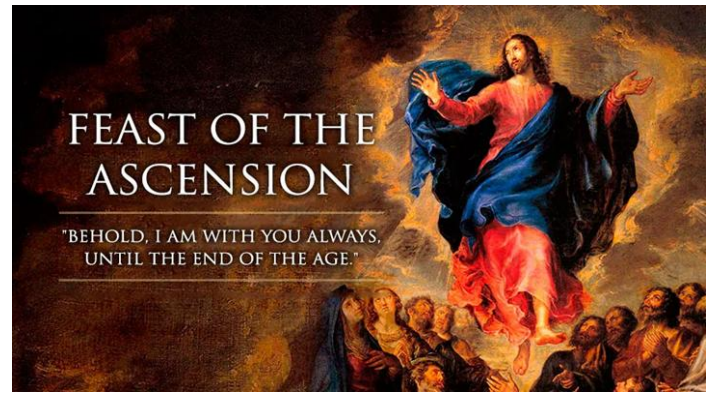
Fr. Dean has been away this week to spend some quality time with family gathered from near and far on the occasion of his son's wedding here at St. Andrew's. In the meantime, the Cathedral is buzzing with activity as always. The annual March for Life Mass on Thursday saw many from Vancouver and elsewhere on the Island make the journey to Victoria to take part, outnumbering our own local participants, with a powerful homily given by Archbishop Smith of Vancouver. Many of our children and teens had a rehearsal last weekend to prepare for their First Communion and Confirmation coming up on Pentecost; the choir is adding new members as they rehearse to bring beauty and honour to our Lord in the Mass; joyful gatherings and meetings are being held by the El Shaddai and KP communities among others; various discipleship-focused small groups are gathering and challenging themselves and one another to transform their lives in response to the Gospel; many are actively seeking out how God is calling them to respond to his love by discerning marriage, priesthood, and religious life.

In a living, vibrant parish, all of these activities and community-forming gatherings are so essential. Consider taking a look through the bulletin and seeing whether there is some group you could join, if you're not involved in one already. Or if you see a need for a group we don't have yet, perhaps let's talk about getting involved in starting it! I can say with experience, it's a lot easier living the Christian life authentically when you can regularly be refreshed and encouraged by others who are doing so too, and we can learn a lot from the varied experience of others outside of our own families. Perhaps you're at a point in life where it's just not possible right now — understandable. How about some holy reading to be stirred up by the wisdom of others?

St. John Bosco wrote "Help yourself during this troubled period by reading holy books. This reading provides excellent food for the soul." St. Padre Pio said "Only God knows the good that can come about by reading one good Catholic book." Maybe check out a book from our under-utilized library in the Parish Centre crammed full with over 3000 books. There's loads of quality reading here and anyone can borrow a book: the writings of saints, lives of holy people, biblical reflections, children's storybooks, enlightening books on just about every faith-based subject. The library is accessible during office hours on weekdays, and we'll happily help you find something to read!

## Ever Wonder What the Knights of Columbus do at St. Andrew's?

During the past year, our council was involved with and accomplished the following:



- Donated and distributed 96 warm winter coats for children through the St. Vincent de Paul Society
- Organized Eucharistic Adoration followed by a meet and greet for men of the Cathedral
- Together with Council 13356 raised \$35,000 and sent 183 wheelchairs to Ukraine
- Helped to host the annual March for Life in Victoria
- Supported 40 Days for Life, Life Chain and Birthright supporting ASAP (Aid and Support after Pregnancy)
- Provided St. Andrew's Regional High School with \$500 for student scholarships
- Purchased and distributed 1,750 carnations to mothers of the Cathedral, as well as Our Lady of the Rosary and Sacred Heart Parish on Mother's Day
- Distributed prayer cards to fathers of the Cathedral on Father's Day
- Organized a Food Drive for St. Vincent de Paul Society which raised 3,500 pounds of food and \$3400 cash
- Helped prepare and host a BBQ for 160 people following children's Confirmation in June
- Supported a Seminarian with prayers and financial assistance
- Supported the annual Corpus Christi Procession at Queen of Peace parish
- Assisted Deacon Philip's Stella Maris Ministry for seafarers
- Donated \$1500 to the Cathedral Restoration Fund
- Donated \$2466 to the Soup Kitchen
- Assisted at the Welcoming Table after Sunday Masses.
- Established a blood donation team
- Laid wreaths at the cenotaph on Remembrance Day
- Organized a Christmas Party for children and adults

- 7 nights in Seoul: \$3750 (double occupancy) or \$4270 (single occupancy)
- 9 nights in Seoul with a full-day tour: \$4230 (double occupancy) or \$4900 (single occupancy)

At this early stage, we’re reaching out to parishes to gauge interest from youth, families, and leaders who may wish to participate in this pilgrimage.
