## Sacramental Information

**Baptism:** If you are seeking the Baptism of an infant, please contact the parish office at 250-388-5571. As Baptism is the first Sacrament of initiation into the Christian faith, we expect that the parents (or guardians) desire to raise the child in the Christian faith and will attend Mass regularly.

**Marriage:** Because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

**Funeral:** Individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

# From the Rector's Desk

3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Lent – March 8

Other than a slight delay to wait for a plaster expert to address some repair issues, the paint restoration in the Cathedral is going very well. Our heritage building engineer consultant, John Dam, and our contractor, 'Double A' Painting, are doing a great job and the completed portion is looking really good. Thanks be to God! Tuesday is my usual writing day for both Rector's Desk and my Sunday homily, but this week my membership on the Council of Priests consumes the majority of Tuesday. Most of us clergy serve both as pastors as well in other capacities within the Diocese. From within the Council of Priests, I also have an obligation to serve as a 'Consultor' to the Bishop, a canonical role when there are significant decisions the Bishop needs to make. I'm just stepping down after a four-year tenure as administrator for the Indigenous Reconciliation Fund Committee that I helped establish at Bp. Gary's request. I am also on the Diocesan Pension Committee but have limited responsibility. With the expansive requirements of caring for the Diocese's largest parish, I often pray there'd be more clergy to share the load. Thanks for heeding the call to pray for more vocations in general and priests in particular. The addition of Frs. Claude and Bernard has answered our prayers.

My week includes a number of consistent commitments and a wide variety of occasional duties. Each week I have an early morning men's Scripture Study (welcome men) followed by a staff meeting with a growing staff that needs to communicate well and support each other in the mission of the Cathedral. Some may have heard, that our Office Assistant Anjali John has resigned and so we'll be looking eventually to fill her position. Of course, the most important consistent 'work' I do is sacramental and I spend daily time in the confessional (I'm never lonely), followed by the daily Mass. There are occasional liturgies to officiate and celebrate like Diane Picken's beautiful funeral last Saturday, and functions like the Diocesan panel on Euthanasia prevention that I need to be present for. Baptism classes, RCIA talks, leading stations of the cross, many daily pastoral appointments, and a retinue of communication and correspondence, fill my calendar to the brim each week. I've joked that we clergy are 6 days invisible and 1 day incomprehensible; but just as I believe that we should have stewardship education and financial literacy in the parish, so too should you know something of what your Rector (and my fellow staff) does to serve you in Christ.

This week we'll be privileged to have Bishop Joseph Nguyen from the Diocese of Kamloops leading us in a mission of Lenten spiritual growth "from the Cross to Hope". It would be wonderful to see most of you taking advantage of this occasion of grace. See the bulletin for details on the times to gather Monday through Wednesday; and remember the Penitential Service Tuesday the 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm with multiple priests available. Thanks in advance to the cooks who have stepped up to offer our clergy Vietnamese, English, and Italian dishes; we're grateful. Finally, in our Lenten lessons on financial literacy (part of an education in stewardship) this weekend we'll learn something about our budgeting in light of our highest attendance since 2015, but with increased costs, expanded staffing for mission, and lagging donations. We're planning for about a \$47,000 deficit this year. While we are not in any kind of crisis, the Parish Council, Finance Committee and I just want you to know more about where your donations are spent with a sense of gratitude to God. Bless your Lent; we're almost halfway to Easter.


## Stewardship: Budget

*"In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead." (James 2:17)*

## Did You Know: Budget

- Parish Mass attendance has increased by a significant amount over the past 2 years, and at present is at the highest level since 2015.
- To address the needs of a large and growing congregation, the 2026 Parish Budget provided for additional staff positions in select areas (Assistant Priest, Pastoral Assistant, Youth Ministry).
- Operating expenses also increased in a number of other areas due to inflation and other factors (security, building repairs).
- While parishioner donations have risen recently, this growth has been, in general, less than the growth in operating costs, and congregation attendance. Over the last 2 years, Mass attendance has increased by almost 30%, while collections have grown by the lesser amount of 21%.
- As a result of these increased operating costs, and restricted donations, an overall deficit of \$47,000 is forecast for the Cathedral Parish in 2026

## Early Learning/Child Care Operators Wanted



### What is “Lectio Divina”?

Latin for “Divine reading”, Lectio Divina is a traditional method of praying with scripture that comes out of the monastic tradition, but which is easy to practice is everyday busy life. It consists of 4 steps:

1. **Read.** Select a short passage and read it slowly and intentionally. Imagine yourself in the scene. Pay attention to anything that stands out to you – a word, a phrase, an image, a question...
2. **Meditate.** Let the words sink in. Reflect on them while sitting in the presence of God.
3. **Pray.** Allow the meditation to lead you into conversation with God. How is God speaking to you through His Word today? How is he asking you to respond?
4. **Contemplate.** Rest in God's presence, letting go of thoughts and words, simply being with him, receiving his love as a gift.

### What is Intercessory Prayer?

*Intercessory prayer is a vital practice in the Christian faith. It involves praying on behalf of others. This gift allows believers to support one another spiritually. Through intercession, prayers become a powerful tool for change.*


*Intercessory prayer means praying specifically for others. Unlike personal prayer, where one asks God for their own needs or guidance, intercession focuses entirely on the needs of the person asking for prayer. It is an act of love and compassion, showing concern for the well-being of others. Intercessors stand in the gap between God and those they pray for, acting as spiritual advocates. This kind of prayer is often persistent and filled with faith, trusting that God hears and responds.*
