Baptism: If you are seeking the Baptism of an infant, please contact the parish office at 250-388-5571. As Baptism is the first Sacrament of initiation into the Christian faith, we expect that the parents (or guardians) desire to raise the child in the Christian faith and will attend Mass regularly.

Marriage: Because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

Funeral: Individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

From the Rector's Desk

18th & 19th Sundays in Ordinary Time

A serious accident Saturday the 18th left my family and I in a state of trauma and for a week and half were keeping vigil in hospital and providing loving support to those needing it most. Some of you are both aware, and have offered a plethora of prayers and expressions of love for which we are incredibly grateful. As of writing this piece on July 30th, we are praising God for miraculous healing mercies and have confidence that the sweet 14-month-old-girl is making a full recovery. We can't believe it but she was discharged from hospital yesterday. Thanks for being a solid extended family and thanks be to God.

Pictured is the return of the altar server field trip and picnic at Gowland Todd Park near Butchart Gardens. I was able to secure a St. Andrew's School bus making the transportation a breeze, and for which we are so grateful. Although Ben our Server coordinator as well as Giordano, our Youth Discipleship coordinator was a support, the leadership for the event came from the servers themselves. When I arrived two years ago the Parish Council advised me to do everything possible to build back up a sense of Catholic community at the Cathedral, and the joyful increase in Altar Server numbers is a bit of evidence of just that. So was the gathering of Young Adults this past Sunday at Willows Beach. We also plan to offer coffee on the Blanshard Plaza after the Sunday Masses as the summer progresses. The hope is that all would find themselves in a spiritually significant small group for study, healing, and service in order to build up our sense of familial love. Glory to God. This emphasis upon youth ministry is certainly bearing fruit in the vocation department as I have a handful of young people in conversational discernment about priesthood and religious life. As mentioned previously, in my estimation we now have an excellent complement of staff and volunteers for effective, faithful and fruitful ministry to fulfill the Lord's expectation of missionary movement at the Cathedral. This is what your stewardship contributions are supporting and we are very grateful.

On the spiritual front, I'd like to plan for an additional occasion for the exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for prayer in the community. Currently, during the school year, I offer a holy hour after the last Saturday Vigil Mass with a special participation of the young adults. Fr. Claude offers a time of exposition prior to his weekly Saturday morning Mass and starting August 5th, we'll plan for an extended time of exposition following the Wednesday weekday Mass. Fr. Claude will repose the Blessed Sacrament at 3:00 p.m. after recitation of the Divine Praises. We need to be assured that there will always be

someone present in the Cathedral between approximately 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. If you're able to commit to a period of time on Wednesdays, please let me know. While prayer isn't the totality of our faith, it is certainly foundational. As St. Mother Teresa reminded us "the fruit of prayer is faith, the fruit of faith is love, the fruit of love is service, and the fruit of service is peace". May it be so at St. Andrew's.

Interested in Becoming Catholic?

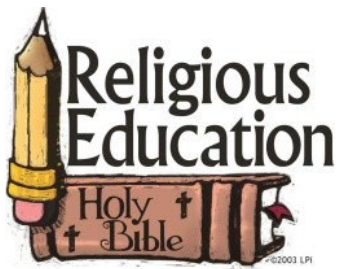
(RCIA — Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)

Sacramental Preparation 2026-27 Registration Open!



Registration is now open for the 2026-27 year of Sacramental Preparation! Children at least 7 years old and teens will receive weekly catechesis to help nurture them in the faith and grow as a community

while preparing to receive the grace of the sacraments of Reconciliation (Confession), Eucharist (1st Communion), and Confirmation.

Our sacramental preparation program is designed as a two-year program running from fall into the spring. Children in Year 1 will prepare for the sacrament of Reconciliation, then in Year 2 they will prepare for the reception of their First Communion as well as Confirmation. Teens will prepare for any sacraments they may have missed in a separate one-year program.

The Feast of the Transfiguration

Celebrated on August 6th, the Feast of the Transfiguration commemorates Jesus revealing His divine glory to Sts. Peter, James, and John on Mount Tabor. His face shone like the sun and His clothes became dazzling white. Moses and Elijah appeared beside Him, representing the Law and the Prophets, showing that Christ fulfills all of Scripture. A bright white cloud representing the Holy Spirit covered them, and from the cloud the Father's voice declared "This is my beloved son, in whom I'm well pleased, listen to Him," affirming Jesus' divine authority (Matthew 17:5).

The events of the Transfiguration of the Lord are thus a revelation of the Trinity, as well as a revelation of the final glory and perfection of the savior.



The Solemnity of the Assumption

Celebrated as a Solemnity on August 15th, the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary offers hope to the faithful in the destiny that awaits those united with Christ. At the end of her earthly life, Mary was taken body and soul into heavenly glory so that the flesh of the Mother of God would be spared the corruption of the grave.

The Assumption is understood to be a singular privilege granted to the Blessed Virgin Mary because of her role as Mother of God and her freedom from sin, making her the first to fully share in the resurrection promised to all believers.

- Apr. 26 Afternoon departure from Vancouver to Venice.
- Apr. 27 Afternoon arrival in Venice. Transfer to hotel in Venice for rest, dinner and overnight.
- Apr. 28 Full day in Venice. We relish the sights and sounds of this serene city including canal cruise by motor launch to St. Mark's Square. We view the bridge of Sighs, Doge's Palace and St. Mark's Basilica. Afternoon Mass, some free time for leisure before returning to the hotel in Venice for dinner and overnight.
- Apr. 29 Today we travel to Siena. We stop in Padua and we visit Basilica of St. Anthony, his tomb and we celebrate Mass. Continue to Florence, the cradle of the Renaissance. Our guided tour of the city takes us to view the church of Santa Croce, a visit to the basilica of Santa Maria del Fiore, Piazza Signora and Ponte Vecchio. Dinner and overnight in Siena area.
- Apr. 30 Our tour of Siena includes the old city, Piazza del Campo, Duomo and St. Catherine Basilica where we celebrate Mass. Some free time before transfer to Assisi, the city of St. Francis, for dinner and overnight.
- May 01 Full day in Assisi. We visit the church of St. Maria degli Angeli with a chapel built by St. Francis (Porziuncola). Continue to the Basilica dedicated to St. Francis. We also visit the Sanctuary of the Spogliazione where St. Carlo Acutis is buried. Some free time before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.
- May 02 This morning, we depart to San Giovanni Rotondo. En route we stop in Lanziano, the site of the Eucharistic Miracle. Continue to San Giovanni Rotondo for dinner and overnight.
- May 03 We start our day with Mass at the Church where Padre Pio said Mass most of his days, and then we visit his tomb and the museum. Afternoon we depart for Monte de San Angelo, the oldest shrine in Europe dedicated to the archangel Michael. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.
- May 04 Today we travel to Rome. En route we stop in Monte Cassino, site of the oldest Benedictine monastery and witness of one of the fiercest battles of the WWII. Upon arrival in Rome Mass, dinner and overnight.
- May 05 This morning, we attend the Audience with the Holy Father. Afternoon our tour of Rome takes us to the Basilica of St. Paul's in Chains, the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore, view the Coliseum and Forum Romanum. Mass in one of the churches in Rome. Dinner and overnight.
- May 06 After breakfast we visit the famous Vatican Museum including the Sistine Chapel and the Basilica of St. Peter. Mass in one of the churches in Rome, some free time, dinner and overnight.
- May 07 Early morning we leave for the airport for a flight to Vancouver. Noon arrival
