**Baptism:** If you are seeking the Baptism of an infant, please contact the parish office at 250-388-5571. As Baptism is the first Sacrament of initiation into the Christian faith, we expect that the parents (or guardians) desire to raise the child in the Christian faith and will attend Mass regularly.

**Marriage:** Because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

**Funeral:** Individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

# From the Rector's Desk

## Divine Mercy Sunday

Wow! Praise the Lord for such full and faithful liturgies in which we entered into the passion, death, and Resurrection of Jesus our God. We're now in the Octave of Easter, these eight days in which we continue the celebration of the Easter miracle. I'm breathing deeply with a sense of immense gratitude (and relief), like many others who lovingly and intensely sacrifice in service of our worship over the Triduum. I'm looking forward to basking in this beautiful season of Easter as it corresponds with the robust signs of spring in Victoria. It was a small and necessary mercy that the paint crew vacated St. Andrew's for Bishop Gary's celebration of the Triduum, but they will resume the paint project this week with anticipation of completion at the end of the month. Many have commented on how good the Cathedral is looking with this significant beautification. St. Andrew's has all the outward signs of being well-loved as an extension of our love for God himself. If you're moved to contribute to the significant cost of the painting, we'd be most grateful.

On Wednesday the 15<sup>th</sup> of April I celebrate my vocation to Catholic priesthood on my 19<sup>th</sup> anniversary, for which I am eternally grateful. Some of you were at St. Andrew's the day of my ordination in 2007 on Divine Mercy Sunday to celebrate with me. Time flies. By coincidence, my intention is to be at Westminster Abbey in Mission from next Tuesday through Friday for a post-Lenten/Easter faith 'fill up' in order to continue giving in Christ's service. All vocation is a positive response to the calling of God, but it also requires continual intimacy with Jesus upon whom all vocation depends. If anyone wishes to speak about a possible calling to priesthood or consecrated life, I'd love to have a conversation about it. Fr. Bernard who is enjoying immensely a sabbatical after 41 years since his ordination in Ireland, will be temporarily away for a month in Ontario for a renewal program for clergy as part of his 'faith fill up'. We'll see him again in May. Speaking of the Abbey, the community of Benedictine monks has been part of my Christian discipleship for over 40 years and have become something of an extended part of my family. I'm glad that my 5<sup>th</sup> annual parish retreat there in June is now full and taking a waitlist. The 200 acres in Mission is saturated in the peace of Christ and is a special place to foster the universal vocation to holiness that we all share by virtue of our baptism.

Our new Director of Music Iason Giagtzoglou, with his one-year work permit (anticipating an extension) intends to arrive on Tuesday April 14<sup>th</sup> and immediately commence

his ministry. This will be the fruit of significant work for our music committee and a considerable challenge in obtaining a Canadian work permit. Please welcome Iason (pronounced Yasson) at our weekend Masses and greet him, especially if interested in joining the music ministry.

Not only will the Young Adult (18-30) community gather after the 5 p.m. Mass on Saturday for our ongoing study of the book of Acts, but Giordano will make an invitation at Masses for the youth (grades 8-12) to join in an inaugural gathering at the 5 p.m. Mass next Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup>. Please pray that the parish will foster the faith of all our children and youth who are so close to the heart of Jesus. This Sunday of Divine Mercy will continue the joy of Easter with a special Mass at 1:00 p.m. for the sacraments of initiation for many who were unable to join in the Easter Vigil. That will be following the 9:00 and 11:00 Masses, and prior to the 2:30 p.m. Divine Mercy liturgy. Needless to say, the Cathedral parish continues to show signs of the 'abundant life' that Christ promised in John 10:10. May you and your family be filled and surrounded by abundant faith, hope and love in Jesus' resurrection power.

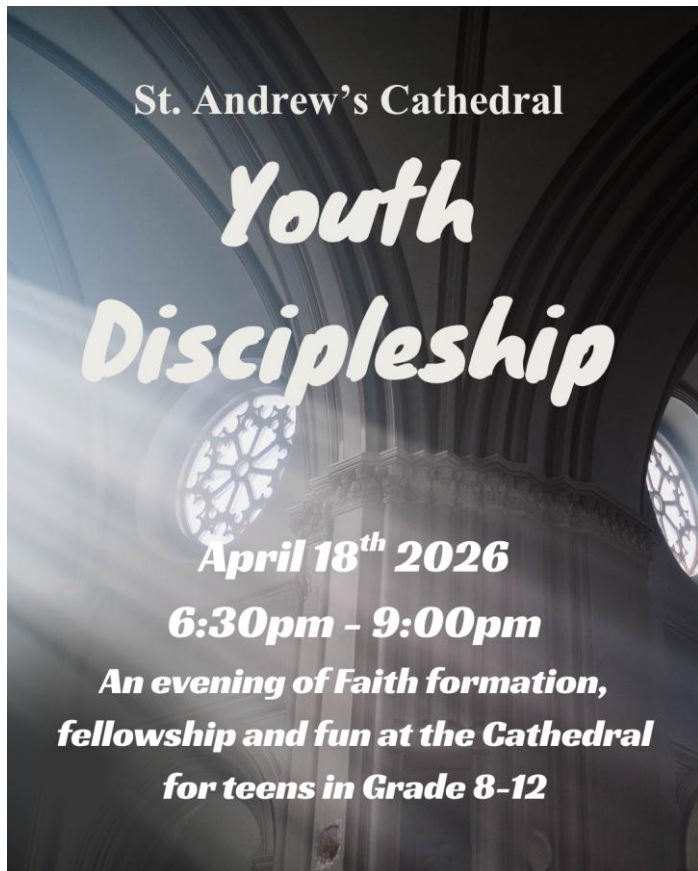
