## Sacramental Information

**Baptism:** If you are seeking the Baptism of an infant, please contact the parish office at 250-388-5571. As Baptism is the first Sacrament of initiation into the Christian faith, we expect that the parents (or guardians) desire to raise the child in the Christian faith and will attend Mass regularly.

**Marriage:** Because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

**Funeral:** Individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

Bernard for covering sacramental duties in my absence. The paint project was successfully concluded just in time for the wedding season (we have another nuptial Mass this coming Saturday) and I want to acknowledge our pastoral council member Chris Ryzuk who skillfully managed everything by liaising with me, our staff, the project engineer, and paint contractor. The detail involved boggles my mind and yet Chris sifted through myriads of emails to ensure we were on time, on budget and the quality of the work was outstanding. 

Dr. Tang is a psychiatrist with The Ottawa Hospital, a member of the Catholic Women's League, and a tireless advocate for the prevention of Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) for mental illness. She recently gave a presentation to the Canadian Catholic Bioethics Institute on this topic. All are welcome to join us to hear her talk at 4049 Godon Head Road.
- The Diocese of Victoria is excited to begin exploring interest in forming a group from across our diocese to attend **World Youth Day 2027 in Seoul, South Korea!** WYD is a powerful international gathering of young Catholics, offering an opportunity for prayer, cultural exchange, and a meaningful encounter with Christ and the universal Church alongside the Holy Father. Preliminary travel proposals that include youth hostel accommodations and roundtrip airfare from Victoria (excluding air taxes and fuel surcharges. Prices are an estimate based on minimum 20 pilgrims):

1. 7 nights in Seoul: \$3750 (double occupancy) or \$4270 (single occupancy)
2. 9 nights in Seoul with a full-day tour: \$4230 (double occupancy) or \$4900 (single occupancy)

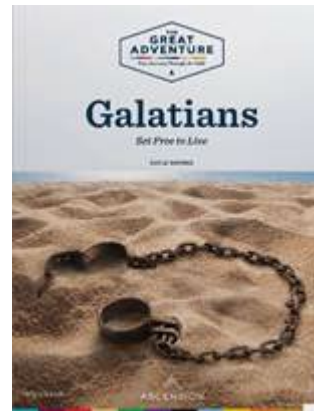

## What Must We Do to Be Saved?

If you have ever wondered like the rich young man "What must we do to be saved?", join us for the **next bible study - Galatians: Set Free to Live**. We will explore St. Paul's



teaching on salvation and the freedom we receive through Jesus Christ. In his letter to the Galatians, Paul addresses important questions in the Christian life and reveals the merciful love of God and the gift of salvation won for us by Christ. Paul explains how Jesus fulfills the Law and calls us to live in the freedom of the Spirit, showing how faith

and works shape the Christian life.

This study helps you discover the freedom God desires for his people.

Course consists of 8 sessions (50-min videos, group discussions, and Q&A). Classes will be 1.5hr long, held on Wednesdays, **beginning June 17 and finishing August 12** (no class on July 1st). Two options for attendance are offered - 2PM in-person at Parish Centre or 6:30PM on zoom video meeting. Facilitator is Bernadette O'Connor. Registration required at Parish Office. Cost is \$35 (with subsidy provided for those in need).
